Sanction is hereby accorded to the release of **Rs. 239.75690 Lakh (Rupees Two Crore Thirty Nine Lakh Seventy Five Thousand Six Hundred and Ninety only)** as Grant-in-aid (Central Share), under "Seed Village programme" and "Certified Seed Production" through Seed Village under "Sub-Mission on Seed and Planting Material (SMSP)" a component of CSS "NMAET" for the projects in favour of Mission Director NMAET (Director Agriculture Jammu) **through BEAMS** for its further placement at the disposal of concerned implementing agencies for its utilization during current financial year (2018-19) against the left out items/components of Approved Annual Action Plan of 2017-18 to be implemented during the financial year 2018-19 indicating details of each item/component.

The release of funds shall be subject to the following conditions:-

1. The HoDs shall indicate in their sanction order, component- wise breakup of the funds to be utilized and furnish the release order copy to the Administrative Department;
2. The funds shall be utilized strictly on the left out components as per the approved work plan of 2017-18 under CSS "Sub-Mission on Seed and Planting Material (SMSP)" of National Mission of Agriculture Extension and Technology (NMAET)- and as per the guidelines of the scheme to be utilized during 2018-19;
3. The HODs shall ensure that accounts are maintained and are subject to normal process of statutory audit likewise, an inventory of the assets created under the projects should be carefully preserved and assets that are no longer required shall be transferred to the Nodal department for its use and re-deployment where ever possible,
4. The drawing and disbursing officer shall ensure that funds released are utilized prudently and judiciously and in no case they should book the expenditure in contravention to the guidelines of the scheme;
5. The expenditure shall be incurred only after observing all codal formalities required under rules,
