Sanction is hereby accorded to the revalidation of un-spent balance of **Rs.49.283 lacs (Rupees Forty Nine Lacs Twenty Eight Thousand and Three Hundred only) which includes ₹ 37.753 lacs relating to FY 2014-15 and ₹ 11.53 lacs relating to FY 2015-16** in favour of Mission Director NMSA (Director Agriculture Kashmir) under Centrally Sponsored Scheme, "Rainfed Area Development Programme" a component of National Mission on Sustainable Agriculture (NMSA) for its utilization during 2017-18.

The revalidation of funds shall be subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The funds shall be utilized as per Approved Work Plan of 2014-15 and 2015-16,
- ii. The HoDs shall ensure that project-wise accounts are maintained and are subject to normal process of statutory Audit, an inventory of the assets created under the projects be preserved and assets that are no longer required shall be transferred to the Nodal department for its use and re-deployment, wherever possible;
- iii. The drawing and disbursing officer shall ensure that funds released are utilized prudently and judiciously and in no case they should book the expenditure just for the sake of spending;
- iv. The HODs shall restrict the expenditure to the actual availability of funds and **no liability shall be created in any case;**
- v. The expenditure shall be incurred only after observing all codal formalities;
- vi. The Department shall ensure that there is no overlapping/duplication in adoption of schemes/incurring of expenditure from any other scheme of the State or Central Government;
- vii. The department shall furnish progress (both physical and financial) alongwith Utilization Certificate to the Administrative Department by or before 31-03-2018 for its submission to Govt. of India;
- viii. Director Finance/FA/CAO of the Department shall vouchsafe the utilization of the funds as per the codal procedures/GoI guidelines;
- ix. The Nodal Officer (NMSA)/ HoD's while releasing the funds to the implementing agencies should indicate component wise break-up of the funds to be utilize in accordance with the approved Action Plan and furnish the release order copy to the Administrative Department; and



- x. Wherever Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) is involved, applicable guidelines including Aadhar linkage shall be complied with strictly.
