ORIENTATION OF FARMERS: INTRODUCTION

The human resource in agriculture and allied sectors comprises of two entities, first the Officers and officials of the development departments and second and the most important are the farmers who are an important changemaker in the Agri landscape of the Union territory.

Grounding of the 29 interventions proposed by the apex committee headed by Dr. Mangla Rai, (Ex DG, ICAR) requires the capacity building of the farmers of the Union territory besides the employees of the development departments. The exercise of capacity building/training of the employees of all the developmental departments in three stages (UT level, Divisional level and District level) has been completed. The next step is Human resource development of farming community of the UT for which a massive outreach programme/Orientation shall be carried out.

The Orientation of farmer's shall be carried out to apprise them about the holistic interventions/ programmes which are to be implemented under HADP in coming five years. The scale of orientation programme shall be en - mass, such that all the farmers get to know about all the proposed interventions under the 27 projects of Holistic Agriculture Development Programme (HADP).

THE SCHEDULE OF ORIENTATION

ORIENTATION SCHEDULE: The orientation shall begin in the month of April from 24th April 2023 onwards till 31st August 2023. The orientation's have been devised in such a way that there is minimal effect on the routine working of the departments and farmers are also well acquainted with the interventions/programmes under HADP. The orientations shall be held for **THREE DAYS** only in a week.

A detailed date wise calendar for Jammu division and Kashmir division has been devised after accounting for the holidays. There shall be 19 training sessions of same programme so that almost all panchayats are covered in each block. For convenience of farmers as well as the organising departments only one panchayat (or two in case the total panchayats are more than 19 in any block) should be covered in single day of training.

There shall be **10695 TRAINING SESSIONS COVERING ALL THE PANCHAYATS OF THE 20 DISTRICTS.** Each district of the UT will host **57 training sessions** over a period of around **FOUR MONTHS (127 days)**

VENUE OF ORIENTATIONS

The orientations shall be held at the level of PANCHAYATS in BLOCKS in the districts, the details of Panchayats and blocks identified for orientations have been mentioned in following pages (Annexures). The venues shall be decided by District Nodal Officer Orientation (HADP) mutually in consultation with officials of the Developmental departments and Supervisory Officers (Heads of Departments) nominated by the Agriculture production department.

The venue should ideally be located in easily accessible central location in Panchayat Ghar or BDO Office or any mutually decided venue. Venue can also be at any one location of 2 or 3 Panchayat clubbed together under the block wherever feasibility is established by the District Nodal Officer.

RESOURCE PERSONS

Since all the Officers and Officials of the developmental departments have already been trained as master trainers/trainers, they shall be acting as RESOURCE PERSONS for the farmers orientation. The resource persons for the orientations shall be the Block level/ Panchayat level Officers/Officials of the

Developmental departments of Agriculture / Animal Husbandry/ Sheep Husbandry/ Fisheries / Horticulture / Sericulture.

The resource persons shall be nominated by Distt Nodal Officers beforehand in consultation with Distt heads of Agriculture and allied departments. DNO's shall have the authority to undertake rationalisation of the Resource persons for deployment at the venue of Orientation

SKILL GAP STUDY/BASELINE SURVEY

Separate Resource persons shall be nominated for each venue for the purpose of carrying out the Baseline survey/Skill gap study. The Baseline survey/Skill gap study is to be carried out using GOOGLE FORMS (Link shall be shared separately with DNO's) so that real time data is populated in backend without the need for physically submitting the same. 2-3 Resource persons shall be nominated by DNO's drawn from all the departments under Agriculture production department deputed for the purpose of carrying out this activity.

The data so generated shall be extrapolated to ascertain the skilling needs of the farmers and shall be of immense help in designing/improvising the skill

development courses, commensurate with the existing skill sets of the farmers and the need for upskilling in cases where such a need is reflected.

ORIENTATION STUDY/DEMONSTRATION MATERIAL

To make the orientation more interesting and engrossing for the farmers a unique way of engaging them through AUDIO-VISUAL AIDS is proposed. The orientation study material shall comprise of 27 VIDEOS of HADP and 18 VIDEOS of CENTRALLY SPONSORED SCHEMES which are of around 5-minute duration each, besides videos of success stories of farmers in various sectors.

These videos depict all the broader contours of the intervention proposed besides the details about various components under the programme, the benefits/subsidies available and procedure of how and whom to apply for under the scheme. The links to these videos on the YOUTUBE CHANNEL of APD shall be shared separately by the Resource persons with the farmers who attend the orientation programme.

Arrangements (AV Aids) shall have to be made in advance by the District Nodal Officer in consultation with the District Officers concerned from developmental

departments for screening of the videos on TV sets or projector screens. As far as possible pooling of resource should be carried out in the district.

CONDUCTING THE ORIENTATION: INSTRUCTIONS

- ❖ At the outset prior information about the ORIENTATIONS have to be spread beforehand through the field functionaries so that farmers know about the massive outreach programme being organised.
- ❖ The GOOGLE FORMS link created shall have to be shared beforehand with the Officers/officials carrying out the skill gap study/baseline survey. This information shall have to be mandatorily collected for all the farmers who attend the orientations and submitted on real time basis. The resource persons carrying out the skill gap/baseline survey should not be the same who are carrying out the orientation. Prior training of such Resource persons shall be carried out by DNO's concerned.
- ❖ Distt Development Council Chairmen / Members, Block Development council Chairmen / Members, Members of Advisory Board for Development of Kissan and PRI Members, Prominent people of the area, Progressive

 farmers and Successful farmers have to be invited to the Orientation and they shall be part of the exercise till completion.

- ❖ **FEEDBACK** regarding the conduct of orientation of the farmers shall be shared by DNO's with Dr. Veer Abhimanyu Koul, Technical officer, APD who shall be Nodal Officer for the purpose.
