Terms of Reference for the Committees

a Jamul mily

The committees shall collect all the relevant information pertaining to the crops and products in terms of their specialty, yield, process etc. to make it eligible for G.l. tagging.

- The committee shall also provide specific characteristics and origin of the crop to be GI tagged and any other specific characteristics which will qualify it for tagging.
- The committee shall complete the process within a period of 6 months and submit the report to the concerned Authorities for further necessary action.

## Point of reference for the Committees

The G1 tagging is registered under the Geographic Indication and Protection Act 1999 by Department of Industry Promotion and International Trade, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Gol:

- 1. The applicant can apply before the Registrar GI directly or via any person or association of person or producer or organization authorized by or under the law which ultimately represents the interest of such producers of such goods.
- The application must entail the criteria of quality, nature, reputation, or any 2. other essential factor like geographical environment, manufacturing process, natural and human factors, map of the territory of production, the appearance of geographical indication (figurative or words), list of producers. along with prescribed fees.
  - The preliminary scrutiny for any deficiencies in documentation etc. shall be 3. conducted and in case any such deficiency is found, it shall be rectified within one month of the date of the communication.
  - 4. The Registrar may accept or refuse the application for registration of G.I. tagging of any product on merit. In case of refusal, the Authority will furnish the reasons for rejecting the application(s) to the applicants. The applicant has the option to file the objection before the Authority within a period of three months.
  - 5. The Registrar, on acceptance of application, may advertise such application on GI Journal.
  - The Authority shall reserve the right of withdrawing the G.I. tagging of any 6. product in case of default from the end user.
